






### Publishing to the Public Site






Course Status	Description
Pending	Initial/default course status, indicates that the course is in a state of development. Not visible to the general public.
Being Reviewed	Indicates that the course has been turned over to the district review process, courses in this status cannot be changed by authors. Not visible to the general public.
Approved	Indicates that the course has been approved by the district review process, courses in this status cannot be changed by authors. Not visible to the general public.
Published	Indicates that the course has been approved by the district review process and published for the general public to see. Courses in this status cannot be changed by authors.
Being Revised	Indicates that the course that has previously been published is now being modified. Course is visible to the general public, but says (Being Revised) behind the course name on every page, the course can be changed by authors.
Archived	Indicates that the course is no longer offered, the course is not visible to most users and cannot be edited other than to change the status in order to recover it from the archived state.
