AIM stands for ACT Instructional Mastery, which is an extensive training program designed for schools and districts seeking professional development to understand each content area of the ACT from a trusted source.

AIM is available as a virtual(online) delivery and in-person(onsite) delivery to schools, school systems and educator organizations.

AIM is valuable professional development that provides educators with teaching strategies that can be integrated immediately into regular classroom instruction while also boosting teacher knowledge, skills, and confidence. Schools that currently outsource test prep programs can bring them in-house for significant savings potential.

Each content course is a two-day course that is scheduled for 7.5 hours per day with a 30-minute break for lunch. Schools and districts can schedule their own training date(s) for courses through their state Account Executive.

The cost for each 2-day workshop up to 30 participants is \$4,700 for the online option and \$6,600 for the onsite option per course. The Official ACT Prep Guide is also required for each course. (Pricing for Sept 1, 2022-Aug 31, 2023)

Schools and districts can purchase participant vouchers at the rate of \$628 per participant for each two-day course. These vouchers can be used at our national quarterly offerings found on our website. Schools and districts will work with their state Account Executive to select courses and dates for each voucher purchased. (Pricing for Sept 1, 2022-Aug 31, 2023)

In addition to a certificate of attendance, participants can earn a certificate of course content mastery by passing the course-specific *Knowledge Check* assessments.
