



Missouri OER Commons

SMCAA and MOREnet are partnering together to help bring Proficiency Scales and other OER resources to Missouri districts via the [Missouri OER Commons Hub](#)! The Missouri OER Commons Hub includes dedicated sections for Missouri Collections, OER Commons Collections, and the Missouri Working Groups.

The Missouri Collections is viewed two different ways, by Subject or by District/State Resources. In the subject view districts can find information related to various content areas, ranging from computer science to math. The District/State Resources view allows the viewer to look at resources grouped by district submissions and by DESE specific items. Within the District/State Resources area, individuals will be able to find Proficiency Scales submitted by Missouri school districts.

The OER Commons Collection, consisting of Curated Resources and Professional Learning, is where individuals can find information related to specific programs or entities. Some Curated Resources include resources on Game-Based Learning, Code.org, OpenSciEd, and much more! Looking to learn more about OER and how it can benefit your district? Then you will want to visit the Professional Learning portion of the OER Commons Collection.

Last, but by no means least, is the Missouri Working Groups area. This area consists of specific groups where Missouri Educators can submit their assessments, proficiency scales, lesson plans, etc., to share with fellow districts across the state. Items submitted to the Missouri OER Commons Hub goes through this area first and is vetted to ensure high-quality resources are being shared for district use.
