To drive meaningful instructional change, district leaders must be skilled in navigating state accountability systems, verifying data accuracy, and translating performance metrics into actionable classroom strategies. This two-part professional learning workshop equips curriculum and assessment leaders with the tools needed to conduct a comprehensive audit of their Annual Performance Report (APR) indicators and student proficiency data. Participants will learn how to access, analyze, and leverage state portal reports, align curriculum to success-ready metrics, and lead data-driven decision-making processes across their schools.

Session 1 (Morning): Deep Dive – Analyzing Student Proficiency Data for Instructional Impact

- **Focus:** Evaluating student achievement status, growth metrics, and translating data into curriculum and instructional alignment.
- **Key Topics:**
 - Detailed MAP & EOC Performance Analysis: Analyzing MAP/EOC scale score summaries, performance level detail reports, and student group sub-data to identify driving factors in academic achievement.
 - Data-Driven Decision Making (DB2/DB4 Alignment): Establishing collaborative data routines, analyzing student work, identifying root causes, and selecting evidence-based instructional strategies.
 - Curriculum & Assessment Alignment: Mapping local curricula to ACT standards, embedding higher-level item types in summative assessments, and expanding WorkKeys/NCRC integration.
 - Sustaining Data Culture: Equipping instructional coaches and data team leaders with protocols to maintain continuous improvement cycles without initiative fatigue.

Audience: Curriculum Directors, District Leaders, Principals, Assistant Superintendents, and other educational leaders responsible for interpreting and using school and district performance data.
